The Dilemma of Tooth Loss

'Lost Teeth Should Be Replaced Immediately'

Q1. If there is loss of one or more teeth due to any disease or trauma, should the teeth be replaced immediately or there is no time constraint?

Ans. The lost teeth should be replaced immediately. But if a patient has no functional or aesthetic deficit, he/she takes tooth loss for granted. There is a natural consequence, when a tooth is lost and not replaced, it causes supracruption of opposing teeth, tilting drifting of adjacent teeth which disrupts the normal tooth alignment and creates gap with its neighbouring teeth that can lead to decay or gums problems. Moreover jawbone needs stimulus to maintain itself, if the tooth is not replaced the jawbone shrinks both in height and width which eventually complicates the situation and the dentist now has limited options to offer to them.

Q2. What is the number of visits and time required for oral rehabilitation of old age patients who have no teeth present at all?

Ans. It takes at least 4-5 visits and each and every step is very important. The reason being we restore their smile and their bite from scratch. We replace their teeth, restore gums and part of jaw bone and it takes multiple visits and there is no shortcut.

Q3. What are crowns and bridges and in which conditions are these indicated and how many visits are required?

Ans. Crown and bridges is a fixed dental treatment option. Root canal is a very common dental procedure which renders the tooth brittle and a crown is advised to protect the restored tooth from fracture. If the patient has a missing tooth due to any gum disease, decay or trauma, one of the treatment options the dentist offers to them is dental bridge in which a single tooth on each side of the missing tooth is modified and replaced with the bridge.

Q4. Is it possible if a tooth falls out in an accident and if it is washed immediately and replaced, it can heal in a natural way?

Ans. Yes it is possible. This is known as tooth avulsion and is a rapid treatment option. The tooth has a favourable prognosis if replaced within 5min. If 2-3 hours has been lapsed it must be stored in a medium either isotonic solution or milk that is easily available. The patient should store it in milk till he/she visits the dentist.

Then the dentist cleans the socket from which the tooth has been avulsed and then washes the root of the tooth and replant it back into the socket.

The dentist then splints it to adjacent teeth with wire and antibiotics cover is given. The tooth heals favourably within 2 weeks.

Q5. What are the materials used for artificial teeth and can its chewing efficiency be compared to natural teeth?

Ans. Most commonly used materials are acrylic and porcelain. Acrylic is inherently weak and its chewing surface is not well developed. The chewing efficiency that is closest to natural teeth is in implants and fixed crowns and bridges. Dentures are either tooth supported, tooth and gums supported or entirely supported by gums like complete dentures. The chewing efficiency decreases as the support from gums increases.

Q6. Are the gold teeth in reality gold and similar in function to natural teeth? Or they are just an option from fashion point of view?

Ans. Yes this was practised in ancient times and considered as a status symbol. The karat value of dental gold ranges from 10-22 karat. Most commonly used is 16 karat gold and consists of 67% gold. Additional metals include silver, platinum, palladium, zinc, which provide strength. The dental gold is soft enough to be shaped and hard enough to chew food.

Q7. Is hygiene of artificial teeth important like natural teeth or artificial teeth don't need to be cleaned at all?

Ans. It's a misconception that artificial teeth need not be cleaned. Hygiene of artificial teeth is equally important. In case of crowns, gum line is most susceptible to decay and the tooth needs to be brushed and flossed properly. No doubt dentures are removable but if hygiene is not maintained it can lead to decay of tooth that supports the dentures or can cause gums problems, bad breath and oral fungal infections.

Q8. The denture comes out after eating or drinking water. The reason behind is technical fault or some kind of negligence by the patient?

Ans. If the denture is new, there is a normal adaptation phase in which the cheeks, lips and tongue accommodate the denture. So if the denture falls out during the initial adaptation phase that's perfectly normal. If the denture becomes loose after a period of 5-6 months, bone shrinkage is a natural phenomena. The patient needs to visit the dentist to improve the fit. Moreover the process of aging results in inelasticity of cheeks that leads to denture movement. Mostly patients who are candidates of complete dentures have systemic diseases and are on medications. The most common side effect of such medicines is dry mouth which provides inefficient seal and the denture falls out

Q9. Are there any side effects of artificial teeth?

Ans. If hygiene is not maintained properly it can lead to side effects. Sometimes when bridge is provided the patient is sometimes reluctant to get the healthy tooth modified. In case of dentures the patient has excessive salivation, difficulty speaking and ulcers during the initial phase of treatment.


Q10 Can we provide artificial teeth in young patients?

Ans. The treatment option provided to young patients is removable teeth because a child is in growing age. Jaw bone and teeth are continuously growing so if a dentist plans an implant in a growing child, it can become embedded in the bone as the jaw grows. If a crown and bridge is planned there is a need to modify the healthy tooth that can lead to sensitivity and pain due to large pulp chambers. So we mostly avoid fixed treatment options.

Q11. What are the post care instructions given to the patient?

Ans. For crowns and bridges a patient is advised not to chew 24hrs from that side. Avoid hard and sticky foods like walnut, sticky candies, jellies, chewing gum as hard and sticky foods can dislodge the crown/bridge. In case of removable teeth the patient needs to clean the dentures, the teeth and the gums. The patient is also advised not to wear the denture at night because chewing causes stresses to build up in the bone and they need to be released by removal of dentures for at least 6-8 hours/day, else they may lead to early shrinkage of bone.


